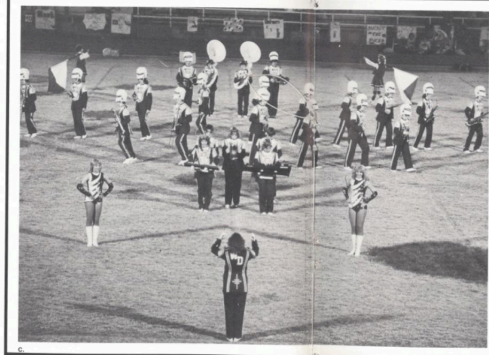

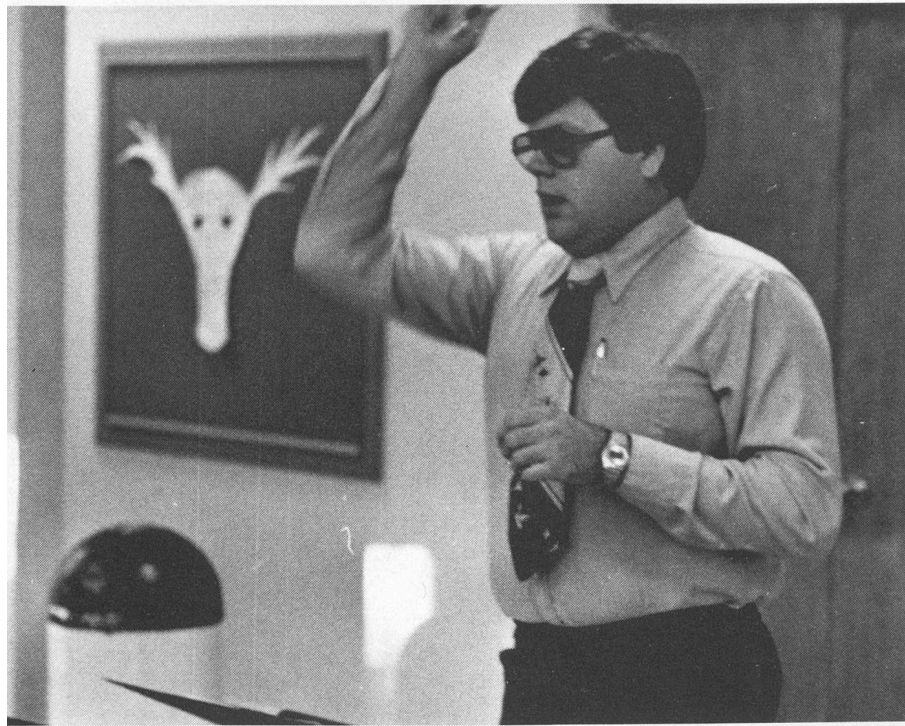

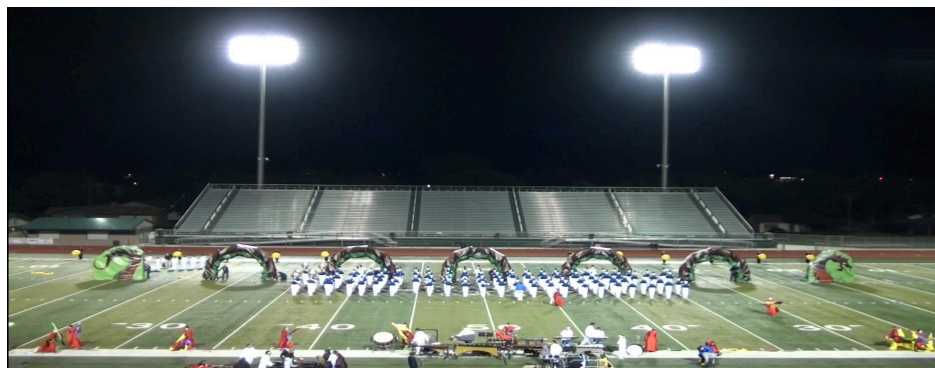

Robinson band receives elite award

The Robinson High School Symphonic Band has been selected as the Texas Class 3A Honor Band.

It is the highest achievement a concert band can earn in Texas and is considered essentially a state championship in concert band, Robinson band director Bob Vetter said.

This is the first time a high

school band in the immediate Waco area, from any classification, has earned this distinction, Vetter said.

"We are thrilled to be named the Texas 3A Honor Band," he said. "This is a testament to the incredible kids here at Robinson ISD. They have a great work ethic and they love to make music."

He also thanked Eric Wilson,

director of bands at Baylor University, for his help.

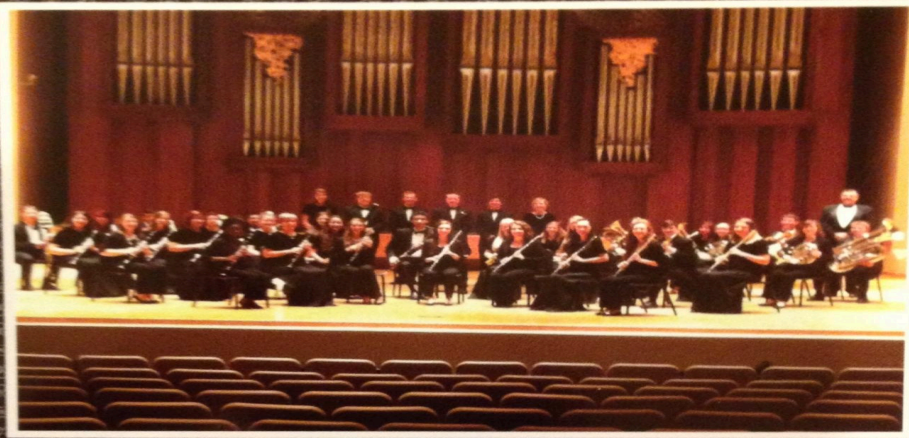
The state contest was July 27 in San Antonio and was sponsored by the Texas Music Educators Association.

For the honor band competition, schools submit recordings from the school year that just completed. Recordings must come from an authorized contest

or public concert.

The contest includes competition at the region, area and state levels.

The Robinson band will present an "honor concert" in the Lila Cockrell Theater at the Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center in San Antonio on Feb. 13, 2015, during TMEA's annual convention.

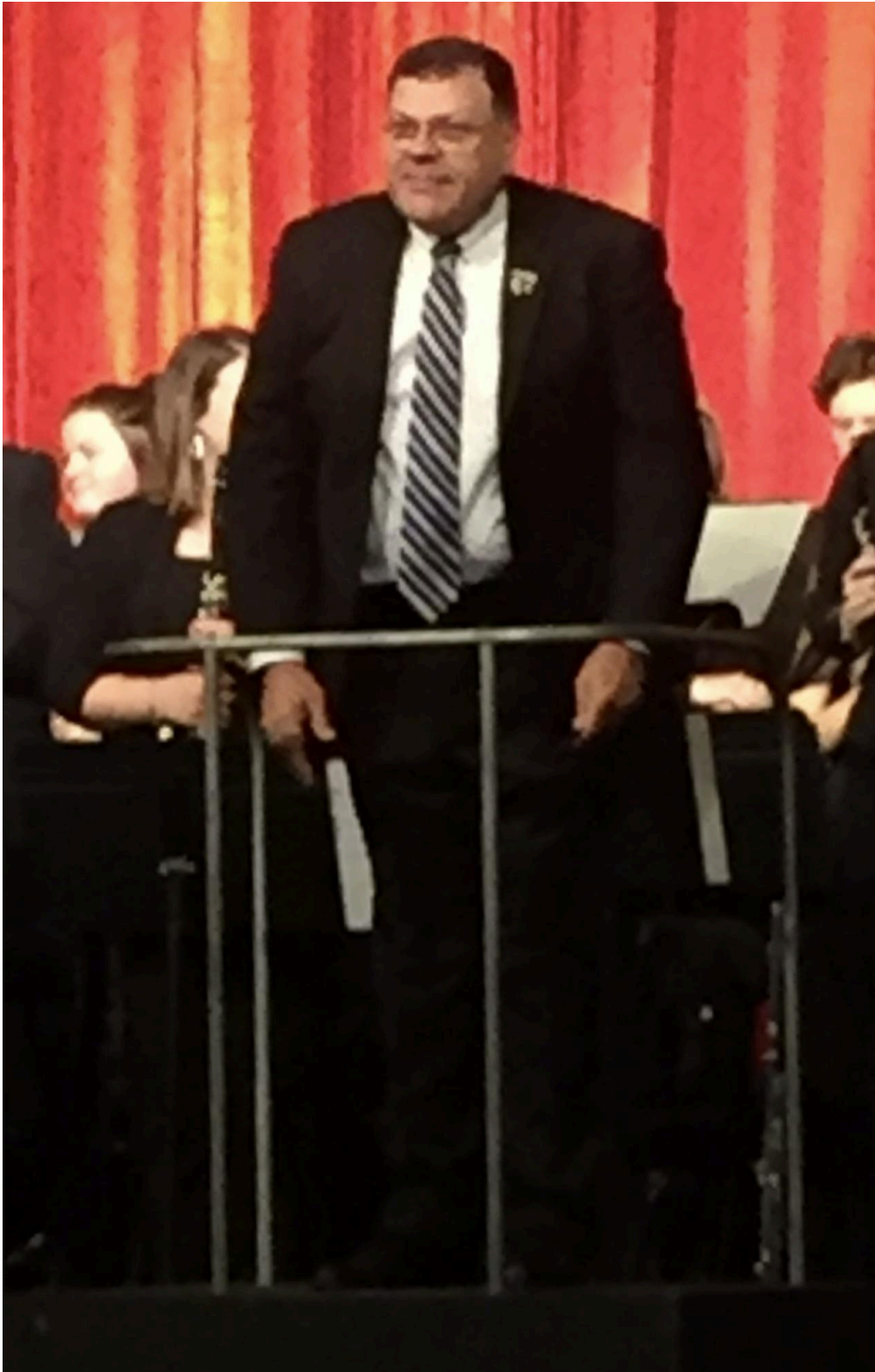
